

TELL ABOUT

When we "tell about", we explain our thinking to others in the group:

"I think"
"I noticed"



WHAT DO YOU MEAN?

RETELL

When we "retell", we explain someone else's thinking to the group:

"He said"
"She said"




COMPARE

"In our book it said"




ADD MORE
